COMBATTING 'FAST FASHION'

The environmental footprint of today's fashion industry is extraordinary, making it one of the top five most polluting industries on earth, alongside the petrochemical industry.

So, what is "fast fashion"? By definition it is inexpensive clothing produced rapidly by mass-market retailers in response to the latest trends. From pesticides to fertilisers, chemicals to high-energy input, non-biodegradable synthetic materials to mass water consumption, fast fashion has a massive detrimental impact on the environment and our health.

A lot of us love a bargain outfit – we buy fast, we buy cheap and too often we wear things once and then throw them out.

However, fast fashion is a major contributor to greenhouse gases, water and air pollution, it creates problematic levels of waste and is often produced through poor working conditions in other countries.







CREATING SUSTAINABLE FASHION

The Environmental Audit Committee demanded the government clean up the industry, making 18 recommendations covering environmental and labour practices. The government says it is dealing with the problem. However, we feel obligated to help deal with the problem, which is why we are doing all we can to oppose fast fashion with our conscious fashion movement.

One of the largest combats of fast fashion is second-hand clothing – extending the life of things that already exist, preventing items going to landfill and slowing mass production. It gives people an alternative way of buying brand new, benefiting people and the planet.

In addition to the obvious environmental benefits, we are helping those less fortunate than us by not only giving those in poverty-stricken areas an affordable way to buy what would otherwise be expensive clothing, we are also providing jobs and opportunities.
